As we've started up a new ministry year, there is so much to be grateful for!

There's an expansion to the Communications Team (tasked with providing church information within and outside our congregation through our website, e-mails, Instagram, Facebook and outdoor signage), working to do some refreshing of the church's website.

We continue to enjoy one another's company at one another's homes through the "Getting to Know You Lunches" each month, and weekly enjoying coffee and tea in the foyer thanks to some new furniture, and Carol and Shirley taking on preparing our hot beverages for us!

Though we've enjoyed one another's company online for our mid-week gatherings, we are excited to finally be offering Provision Time (our Bible Study) and Morning Prayer both in-person and online.

We're excited and grateful to be holding baptism and membership classes this fall – if you are interested and haven't made it out to the classes, please speak to Pastor Ruth! Baptism Sunday will be November 24th and Membership Sunday will be December 1st!

As the leadership teams have restarted the fall meetings, it's excited to see the wheels turning as we resume meeting together with the Mission Team (representatives from all church teams, chaired by the Moderator), Worship Team (facilitation of all aspects of worship at Calvary based on the church year), Ministry Strategy Committee (team to clarify Calvary's core ministry foci and to explore partnerships within the community), Pastoral Care Team (leadership of the church community to share Christ's light to one another in thoughts, prayers, words and deeds), Ganaraska Woods Commission (operates an 84-acre rural Retreat Centre), Grace Pascoe Care Centre (GPCC) Stewardship Group (ensuringresponsible use of funds & property including future potential), while also coordinating with our staff members and those individuals in our congregation focusing on our finances and facilities.

As I think on these things, I think of these words of Paul to the Thessalonians:

'We always thank God for all of you and continually mention you in our prayers. We remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labour prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.'

Calvary Baptist Church FAQs

We are working on a compilation of answers to questions you may have about our church and how it functions. As we put this together, we know that traditional church language can be confusing so let us know if we could help you understand how Calvary "works."

What Does it Mean to be the Church?

Being The Church involves two main aspects of one's personhood – belief and practice: As the Church, we believe that God is Triune: three in one – Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and that we can be in relationship with God in and through the Son – Jesus Christ – and His life, death, and resurrection. That belief impacts our practice in that we seek to place our lives under the lordship of God – orienting our body, heart, mind, and soul towards doing and being all that God calls us to be in and through His Word, both individually and as a group.

Worship Team

Our major project over the summer was refurbishing the Main Street Foyer as a conversation refreshment area. It's a friendly place to sip, nibble and chat after the service. Yet to come is a quiet prayer nook at the north end of the foyer that still needs some TLC.

Historical cabinets, photos and other archival material previously housed in this foyer have been moved to the work in progress "History Hallway" by the offices. If you're interested in history or archival presentation we'd love your input/participation. When completed it will be a testament to God's providence over the years.

CALVARY SPOTLIGHT

I am pleased to report that in July, Calvary was blessed to be able to hire Kelley Maloney as our new Office Administrator. Kelley has been a vital part of Calvary's Food Bank, acting as the volunteer coordinator for the Grace Pascoe Care Centre, since it's reopening in May 2022. We have welcomed Kelley to our finance and facilities team, which is comprised of volunteers and Calvary employees, with much gratitude.

Our finances are holding steady, and although we continue to spend more than we receive, our operating fund and ministries (Ganaraska Woods and our Food Bank) have been receiving more income than expected and spending less than budgeted. This past June, our Food Bank was awarded a one-time, one-year grant of \$15k by the Daily Bread Food Bank. The funds will be used to support food purchases to supplement the weekly food donations, as well as support our volunteers. Our net operating deficit across all ministries was \$23k for the first nine months of the year, vs an expected deficit of \$61k.Calvary has recently received notice that we are to receive a bequest from the estate of Beryl Isaac, who attended Calvary as a child. The bequest will exceed \$300k, to be distributed in two parts in the coming weeks and months. We are most grateful that the bequest will provide some much needed financial breathing room.

The Facilities Team, which has been under-resourced for the rental activities, has been experimenting with adding capacity. This is a work-in-progress which we will report on at the upcoming Huddle scheduled for November 17, 2024.
