## Calvary Renewal Loans Investment Certificate Opportunity

At the April 23, 2023 huddle, the congregation of Calvary agreed to raise funds to support its ongoing operations. We have since learned that the buildings at 72 Main Street are in need of immediate repairs expected to cost as much as \$50,000. In order to continue to support worship and to provide the programs in our community such as seniors and the Grace Pascoe Care Centre food bank, it is important that we maintain the building and infrastructure that we have.

The Treasurer, supported by the leadership, is proposing to offer investment certificates for three-year terms at a rate of 4%. The interest rate compares favourably to CBOQ certificate rates.

### **Care Centre News**

Once again, it gives me great pleasure to report on the progress of our Food Bank. Firstly, I want to salute all of the dedicated volunteers who faithfully and cheerfully give of their time, energy and talents each week. The Wednesday crew receives the skids of inventory from the trucks from both Daily Bread and Second Harvest, carrying them downstairs, sorting and storing in preparation for Thursday opening. Tables for various stations are set up.

Thursday's volunteers arrive early to set up various tables according to food groups and separate eggs and other items into serving sizes. Our clients are very pleased that they are able to choose their preferences so no food is wasted and individual needs are met. As I welcome our neighbours who wait outside before opening time, I continue to receive feedback that "You are the best food bank around and all the volunteers are so nice."

Let me not fail to mention the management, leadership and scheduling, the collective skills and dedication of those who make our Care Centre the pride of our community and Calvary.

The Daily Bread Agency reports that last year July, 239,653 people were served across the city. This year in July, there was an increase of 56%!! There is no denying the need for food security. So, how can you help?

Donations of non-perishable goods can be brought in Wednesday or brought to the basket in the Sanctuary on Sunday. Some of the items most needed are proteins, canned vegetables, diapers, incontinence products and pet food. Please bring in your egg cartons, divided in two for repackaging eggs. Pick up a few items when you do your weekly shopping. Financial support is also appreciated as there is often the need to purchase extra items.

The Care Centre is a wonderful opportunity to show the love of Jesus to our neighbours. Relationships are naturally forming as folks wait for the door to open and as people leave we often hear "Thanks, God Bless you." So, I pass their appreciation on to you.
